

# Northport One Act Play Festival Overview

The Northport One Act play Festival will be held over the weekend of April 16 and 17, 2010.

Saturday, April 17 afternoon performances 3:00 – 5:30 will be made up of five short one act plays, some written and produced by students of the Northport/E. Northport High School. There will be no charge for this session. There will again be music and an opportunity for the audience and students to mingle.

A panel discussion will follow the Saturday afternoon performances where parents, faculty and students will discuss some topics of concern as suggested in the plays. The panel will consist of some selection of an abuse specialist, law enforcement, school administrator, politician, playwright or playwriting teacher, etc.

The general theme of the plays selected to be performed is "Communication." The Saturday afternoon plays are more specifically themed as "Communication between Students and Parents" regarding drug and alcohol use and other concerns. This topic ties in with the goals of the Northport/E Northport Community Drug and Alcohol Task Force with which we are working in cooperation on this project. Staff from the Festival are working with the students and faculty of the school district on this event.
